Thursday:

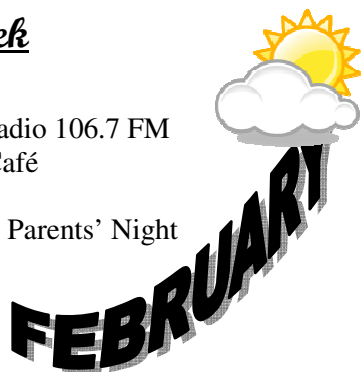
