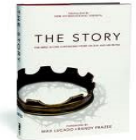

The total work took a long time to complete due to several interruptions from rain and some electricity problems. The tin and fabrication work was completed in the first week of August and the carpentry work was completed in the last week of August. All the tin roof work was completed with the funds you provided. We are thankful to the board for the immediate release of these funds. All the children have now shifted into their renovated dormitory.

At the Girls' Home the girls are happy and enjoying the bunk beds with new mattresses. The girls were so excited when these arrived. Most of them are from rural families who struggle to get one meal a day, so their new bunk bed was a good experience for these girls.
