2¼ YEARS: Child lets go.

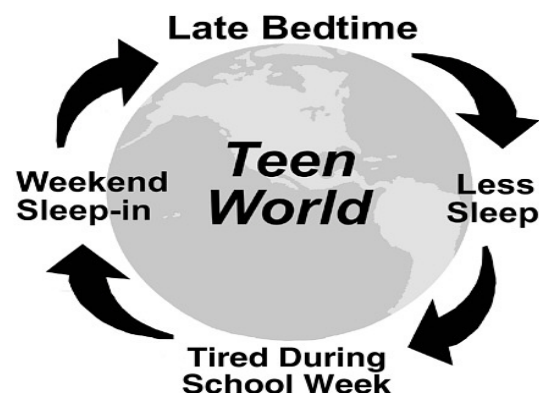
2½ YEARS: Child learns to talk.

Port Hedland, W.A.

An agreement has been initiated to investigate the potential for re-establishing Churches of Christ ministry with an indigenous focus in the Pilbara region and Port Hedland, delivered through Indigenous Ministries Australia. Currently foundations are being established through past connections in the area as well as developing new partnerships to build for the future a community that is resilient, self-reliant and growing. This will take an investment of time, energy and resources. Please remain prayerful about this opportunity and encourage Remy Sese as he prepares to go to Hedland to meet with the community members, survey the church building and prepare a development plan. Following the development plan being accepted, a meeting will be called in Perth to provide interested people with information about the proposal, and to seek support and encouragement in this new direction.
