His dreamy eyes gaze into the future through the dreams within his heart.

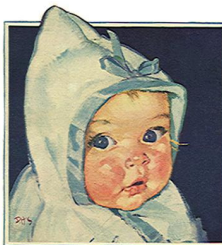
He speaks of love and tenderness, yet in a boyish zest for life his heart of love is in a whirl.

Mission Update

Country Profile - India

India is the world's most populous democracy. It hosts a variety of cultures, languages and religions. India is a contrast on so many levels: boasting rapid growth in technological industries, the most watched film industry in the world and a swathe of new millionaires. It also has crippling poverty, corruption and a still functioning caste system (even though the caste system was made illegal in 1947). Indian civilisation is one of the oldest in recorded history. By the 16th century the Mughal Dynasty was the ascendant power and ruled until the British began to exercise both commercial and political control of India. Independence was granted from Great Britain in 1947, after decades of non-violent protests, led by Mohandas Gandhi. The subsequent partition of the British India Empire into India (Hindu) and East Pakistan (Muslim -later Bangladesh) resulted in approx. 10 million people moving across borders and religious violence that led to the deaths of 500,000 people. India was GMP's first partner country with the sending of Mary Thompson in 1891. We now have partnerships in India at Ashwood memorial hospital in Daund, with children's homes at Ankoor, Baramati and Shrigonda, to name a few.
